- Please respect the leash laws. All pets must be kept on a leash when outdoors, we are receiving numerous complaints about dogs running loose. Please be aware that both the City and County ordinances regarding dogs. Dogs must be kept on a leash and owners must clean up behind their pets. If a dog is loose and comes at you or attacks, please contact the police and make sure you file a police report.
- In the event of another ice storm, please do not put salt or sand on the tennis courts. When ice is present, the tennis courts are closed until all ice is melted. Salt and sand damage the court surface.
- There are numerous street lights burned out in the neighborhood. Please check to see if the lights near your home are out. If so, please call the management office at 770-222-2000 and provide the address closest to the burned out light.
- There have been burglaries and attempted burglaries reported in the neighborhood. Please be aware of all activity around your home and help watch your neighbor's homes. Report any suspicious activity to the police immediately. Make sure your neighbors have phone numbers to contact you in the event anything suspicious is noted around your home. It appears that these burglaries are taking place through the backdoors of homes during daylight hours.
- They are upgrading the utilities in the neighborhood. For your safety and the safety of the workers, PLEASE leave the marker flags in place and ask your children to do the same.
